She has studied African dance, Indian Classical Dance and various drumming styles in Senegal, the USA and Australia, including Haitian, Brazilian and Cuban percussion. As a polyrhythm specialist, Tania's workshops invite participants into the world of simultaneous perception. Entering into voice and rhythm from a deeply relaxed place becomes the foundation for feeling and performing music from a centred and profound sense of self. The rhythmic body and voice are key in unlocking the creative improviser in us all!
